One gas-powered lawn mower produces as much air pollution as 43 new cars

Over 17 million gallons of gas are spilled each year refueling lawn and garden equipment – more oil than was spilled by the Exxon Valdez



The Village of Pleasantville's Climate Smart committee received another grant from NYS and has allocated \$5,000 in rebates to promote the transition from noisy, polluting, gas powered lawn equipment to quiet and efficient electric models.

The details

1. Buy a new electric:

Lawn Mower - get a 50% rebate up to \$125 when you turn in your old gas model. Lawn Mower - get a 50% rebate up to \$75 (for first time buyers - no trade in required). Leaf Blower or Weed Whacker - get a 50% rebate up to \$75 with gas model turn in.

- 2. Bring old gas clunker to the Pleasantville Recycling Center on Sat. Apr 15th or May 6th from 9am 12pm. We'll be there to process your rebate. Bring or email us your receipt. Equipment must be drained of all liquids before they turned in at the recycling center.
- 3. Get a check in the mail

Rebates are first come, first served, while funds last. Must be a village resident. Limit of one mower and one blower rebate per household. Valid for equipment purchased after 3/15/23.
